Scope of Work:

The Contract involves the furnishing and installation of an Event Detection System in Tunnels E and F as part of the PATH Tunnel Improvement program. The work includes, but is not limited to, the installation, testing & commissioning of a redundant array of sensors and related equipment, network equipment, servers, software, access control and Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) monitoring and related infrastructure work that will provide real-time updates as to current conditions in the PATH under-river Tunnels E&F. The events monitored include the presence of water and disturbances that may compromise the integrity of the railway.

Qualification information must be submitted by **4:00 pm, on Tuesday May 31, 2016** and it is anticipated that bid documents will be available to pre-qualified bidders on or about the 2nd Quarter of 2016. In order to pre-qualify for the Contract PAT-084.039, all participating firms must execute and submit “Agreement on Terms of Discussion,” “Non Disclosure and Confidentiality Agreement” and “Contractors Qualification Statement” with their RTQ submittal packages.
