The Contract referenced herein involves the furnishing and installation of new barriers at the New York pier of the Lincoln Tunnel (LT) and repairs to the existing barriers at the New York pier of the Holland Tunnel (HT). The major classification of work may include, but not be limited to: the furnishing and installation of steel bar grating at the HT; and the fabrication, delivery and installation of stainless steel chain link netting at the LT. Work may also include; welding, installation of anchors, and excavation below the mud line. All work must be performed waterside from a work barge.

Qualification information is to be submitted by **4 P.M. on Friday, March 18, 2016** and it is anticipated that Bid Documents for Holland Tunnel will be available to pre-qualified bidders on or about April 2016, and for Lincoln Tunnel will be available to pre-qualified bidders on or about July 2016. Any firm wishing to pre-qualify for this Contract must also execute and submit Attachment I (Terms of Discussion) and Attachment II (Non Disclosure and Confidentiality Agreement) with its RTQ submittal package as well as execute the Business Qualification Questionnaire and submit as per instructions.
