#### **Scope of Work:**

The scope of work consists of removal and replacement of about 110,000 square feet of bridge decks for the 178th and 179th Street Ramps, the East and West Bus Ramp, and the Bus Turnaround; replacement of underdeck electrical conduits; installation of underdeck shielding; replacement of lighting and drainage systems; structural modification of the floor beams for widening the deck of the street ramps; widening the ramp sidewalks, including railing and safety fence; seismic retrofit of the steel fascia columns and column base anchorage; removal and reconstruction of the east half of the 179th Street Ramp; construction of fly-over ramps to provide pedestrian/bicycle access to the ramp sidewalks; concrete repairs for the retaining wall along West 179th Street; concrete repairs for existing offset pier columns at Ramp 179; Routine and Priority steel and concrete repairs; refurbishment of the George Washington Bridge Park located at Cabrini Boulevard and West 180th Street; temporary and permanent relocation and restoration of utilities such as piping, conduits, and electronic devices; Maintenance of Traffic during the stipulated Hours of Work; design and installation of temporary work platforms/scaffolding and containment for construction, including sealing and removal of lead based paint.

Qualification information is to be submitted by **3:00 pm on Friday, April 21, 2017** and it is anticipated that bid documents will be available to pre-qualified bidders on or about June 2017. In order to pre-qualify for the Contract GWB-244.042, all participating firms must execute and submit "Agreement on Terms of Discussion" and "Contractors Qualification Statement" with their RTQ submittal packages.
