#### **Scope of Work:**

The Authority wishes to pre-qualify firms to submit bids for Contract No. GWB-244.049, entitled “George Washington Bridge Trans Manhattan Expressway Median Barriers and Water System ‘C’ Rehabilitation”. The Contract requires work necessary to replace existing Trans Manhattan Expressway median barriers, rehabilitation of existing George Washington Bus Station and Air Rights Building columns, traffic safety improvements, and replacement of water system for fire protection. The work generally consists of, but is not limited to the following: replacement of existing concrete roadway median barriers, rehabilitation of building columns, replacement of overhead roadway signs, permanent guide signs and pavement markings, installation of traffic safety improvements and replacement of existing water system for fire protection.

Qualification information is to be submitted by **2:00 pm on March 8, 2018** and it is anticipated that bid documents will be available to pre-qualified bidders on or about March 2018. In order to pre-qualify for the Contract GWB-244.049, all participating firms must execute and submit “Agreement on Terms of Discussion” and “Contractors Qualification Statement” with their RTQ submittal packages.
