RTQ - Contract PAT-637: PATH – New York and New Jersey Facilities – Building and Site Improvements via Work Order

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The work generally consists of:

Performance of pressure grouting to fill voids and seal water leaks using either cement or chemical based grouts. Provide cutting, patching and removal of existing construction as necessary to perform the pressure grouting. Protection of pedestrian traffic, existing adjacent utilities, and existing surfaces to remain and finished surfaces. Work on active railroad at various tunnels and stations of the PATH system while train services remain in operation. Performance of work in limited work areas with low headroom. Strict coordination with PATH facility forces and other Contractors in order to limit disruptions to the PATH passengers, train services, maintenance operations, and other ongoing construction.

Qualification information is to be submitted by November 27, 2012, and it is anticipated that bid documents will be available to pre-qualified bidders December 2012. In order to pre-qualify for the Contract PAT-637, all participating firms must also execute and submit Attachment A – Contractor's Qualification Statement and Attachment B – Terms of Discussion with their RTQ submittal package.
