**Contract # WTCR-W30-2011-31** – World Trade Center Estimate Range: \$2M-\$5M. The work generally entails finish hardscaping to a plaza area approximately 7,500sf, with the main feature of the development being a green wall consisting of a structural steel frame supporting a series of wire mesh panel assemblies, decorative stone cladding, ivy plantings, and lighting. The work also includes some tree planters and benches.
