

PANYNJ – Ocean-Going Vessel Low-Sulfur Fuel Program Enrollment Form General Instructions

- For initial enrollment in the Program, both the Company and the Vessel enrollment forms must be submitted. Subsequent vessel enrollments only require the Vessel enrollment form to be submitted.
- The Company enrollment form should contain a single line with company information.
- The Vessel enrollment form should contain a single line for each vessel.
- The Company Name entered for each vessel on the Vessel enrollment form must match the Company Name on the Company enrollment form.
- Please fill out each form electronically, limiting responses to what is specified in the headings. Headings may contain specific units (i.e. kW, etc.) or may specify a “Yes” or “No” answer.

Company Enrollment Form Specific Instructions

- **Company Name** - Enter the company name
- **Mailing Address** – Enter the company’s mailing address for receipt of program documents
- **Contact Information** – Enter the contact information of the person responsible for program participation
- **Business Tax ID Forms included?** – Enter “Yes” or “No” to indicate which of the required forms is included

Vessel Enrollment Form Specific Instructions

- **Company Name** – Enter the company name as entered on the company enrollment form
- **Vessel Operator** – Enter the name of the company operating the vessel being enrolled
- **Vessel Owner** – Enter the name of the company owning the vessel being enrolled
- **Vessel Name** – Enter the current name of the vessel being enrolled
- **IMO No.** – Enter the IMO number of the vessel being enrolled
- **Max Rated Speed** (knots) – Enter the rated sea speed of the vessel being enrolled
- **Main Engine Rated Power** (kW) – Enter the rated power of the main engine at the rated sea speed
- **Main Engine Slide Valves Retrofitted?** (Yes/No) – enter "Yes" if the vessel's main engine is known to have been retrofitted with slide valves (installed in the engine after delivery, not when new). Enter "No" for all other cases (i.e., if known not to be equipped with slide valves, if not known, or if equipped with slide valves when new)
- **Average Load on Auxiliary Engines** (kW) – See Figure 1.
 - **Anchorage** – Enter the average load over all auxiliary engines while at anchorage (this information is needed if the vessel may stay at an anchorage during a qualifying arrival or departure and the Company wants reimbursement during qualifying anchorage stays)
 - **at Berth** – Enter the average load over all auxiliary engines while at berth
 - **Maneuvering** – Enter the average load over all auxiliary engines while maneuvering
 - **Ambrose Channel** – Enter the average load over all auxiliary engines while in the Ambrose Channel
 - **VSR Zone** – Enter the average load over all auxiliary engines while transiting within the VSR zone
- **Diesel Electric Vessels Only**
 - No. of Propulsion Motors – Enter the number of propulsion drive motors
 - Propulsion Motor Rating (kW) per motor - Enter the rated power of each propulsion motor
- **Anticipated Level of Participation**
 - No. Calls per Quarter** – Enter the anticipated number of participating calls by this vessel each calendar quarter
