Critical Investments Approved

In ongoing programs to upgrade airport infrastructure to meet current needs and prepare for forecasted demand, the Port Authority Board of Commissioners recently approved new improvement projects for LaGuardia and Newark Liberty International.

The \$255 million LGA initiatives include multiple site and building projects and follow previous authorizations for design and construction of an East Garage and East End Substation. The airport's largest carrier -- Delta Air Lines -- has projects on tap to improve Terminals C and D.

To help reduce ground delays, four new taxiways for Newark Liberty's Runway 4L-22R will be constructed as part of a \$97.3 million rehabilitation expected to begin in early 2014. The airport's longest runway, which was last paved in 2003, will be overhauled with asphalt repaving and replacement of electrical and lighting systems among other repairs. The project will be staged to minimize the impact on operations.

Summer Parking Discounts

Customers of Kennedy and Newark Liberty on-airport parking can take advantage of discounts available until September 7, 2013. At JFK, park five days in the long-term lot and get one day free. Newark Liberty customers who park their cars in daily P1/P3 lots for three days can park the fourth day free. A discount is also available for P6 parking.

Parking on airport is safe and secure and the rates include all taxes -- there are no hidden fees. Easy, free access to the airline terminals is available on AirTrain JFK and AirTrain Newark, both of which run 24/7. (Courtesy shuttles are available from Newark Liberty's P6 Lot.)
