

Aviation Department

Following three months of growth, passenger traffic at ACY fell by 4.1 percent. Spirit, the dominant carrier at the airport, saw a 1.5 percent fall as it carried 1,476 fewer passengers. Spirit's seat capacity fell 2.1 percent, down 2,532 seats. Boston and Orlando led the drop in seat capacity. These two destinations saw a combined reduction of 11,184 seats. International traffic, which is mostly charter, posted its fifth consecutive monthly drop as it fell 100 percent. Domestic charter activity fell 32.5 percent.
