

Aviation Department

Traffic is down 64.1% from last April largely due to AirTran's cessation of service at the end of last summer, while flight activity, down 52.7%, was affected negatively by the slowdown in general aviation, a large component of movements at Stewart. Freight is down 41.1% on 40.3% fewer flights.
