

## Aviation Department

Passenger traffic fell 5% on a 4% seat reduction. The loss was equally split between domestic and international markets, the latter pulled down by weak Transatlantic results as earlier explained. Continental led the traffic decline with a 3% passenger loss on a 3% reduction in published scheduled seats. Overall, Transatlantic markets exhibited a drag on growth falling 10%. Freight rose 15.7% with a 3-to-1 ratio of carriers having gains to those showing losses. Freight growth was split by a lopsided domestic-to-international ratio: of 6.7% to 38.1%.
