

Aviation Department

LaGuardia's passengers again led the region with a strong 12.2% growth on a 2.6% increase in scheduled seat capacity, raising load factors by 9 percentage points, at least partially due to the JFK runway closure. This capacity increase still falls short by 8.7% of the April 2008 scheduled seats. Domestic traffic was up 12.3% while international traffic gained 9.4%.
