

Aviation Department

With an overall 2.7% gain in seat capacity in April, EWR passenger traffic grew 3.5%. Growth was unbalanced as it all came from the domestic sector, where a 6.5% gain in seat capacity contributed to a 6.8% gain in passenger traffic. International seat capacity fell 4.4%, and as a result, the international traffic fell 2.8%. This represents the first decline in international traffic since Oct 2011. Never the less YTD overall traffic remains strong at 6.7%. Similar to JFK, cargo performance was disappointing as cargo fell nearly 10% in April and YTD April cargo is down 12%. Due to the underlying weakness, EWR's 2012 cargo has been revised downward. It is expected to be down 8.6%.
