

Aviation Department

With a 2.6% gain in overall seat capacity in April, LGA remained the fastest growing among our airports as passenger traffic grew a strong 9% in April, pushing YTD April growth up to 6.7%. While domestic gained 8.5%, the international sector gained momentum as traffic grew 20% on a 12% seat capacity gain. International gains were led by Delta's services to Nassau, and by AA and Air Canada to Toronto. Cargo was down 25% in April.
