Easter's shift from April last year to March this year had its greatest impact at JFK. Domestic and international traffic declined 7.8% and 1.7% respectively. Dominant carriers on domestic markets: JetBlue, Delta and American collectively carried 180,000 fewer passengers. Along with the holiday date shift that resulted in traffic declining, JetBlue and American reduced seat capacity to select markets: JetBlue cut 13,300 seats to Florida, and American reduced 11,900 seats to California. A decline in transatlantic routes was the biggest contributor to international traffic slowdown. The cargo sector contracted 0.6%. Although domestic cargo rose 7.9%, the decline in international cargo by 2.5% pulled the sector down due to its hefty 80% share of the airport's total cargo.
