

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ APRIL 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

In contrast to the rest of our airports, LGA was the only facility to grow this month, continuing the strong growth cycle with YTD passenger traffic up 7.2%. Combined international and domestic traffic in April was up 1.9%. Although US Airways, American and UA/CO combined carried 142,000 fewer domestic passengers, Delta and JetBlue together served 206,000 more passengers, lifting domestic traffic by 0.4%. The international sector continued strong growth with WestJet and Delta contributing the most to a 35.8% increase, with expanded destinations to Montreal, Toronto and Halifax.
