

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic fell nearly 23%, continuing downward trend that started with JetBlue reducing seat capacity to Florida destinations and Delta canceling flights to Atlanta, along with cutting capacity to Detroit. As a result, JetBlue, the airport's top-ranked airline, carried 1,900 fewer passengers, and Delta served 6,200 fewer travelers. Due to reduced services, it is highly probable that SWF will continue experiencing passenger attrition.
