Having served 4.4 million passengers, JFK had its best April ever. It reflected volumes usually seen in peak summer months. Domestic traffic jumped 8.7%, while international enjoyed a 16.5% increase following an 11% jump in seat capacity. Overall traffic was up 12.7%. JetBlue, Delta, British, Emirates, Etihad, Norwegian, Tam Brazilian, Aerolineas Argentina, Alitalia and Tame Airlines collectively carried 241,200 more passengers on their international routes. On domestic routes, Delta, JetBlue, United, US Airways, and Virgin America combined to carry 208,200 more passengers. Cargo tonnage at JFK jumped 4.7%, with domestic up 1.2% and international up 5.5%. International cargo was the major contributor not only to JFK, but also to region's cargo, accounting for 55% of the region's tonnage.
