

Aviation Department

JFK had its best April ever serving 4.6 mln passengers. Traffic grew 4.7%, with domestic travel jumping 6.9% and international growing 2.8%. Carriers expanded their seat capacity by 5.4%, with domestic expansion accounting for the most seats. Delta, JetBlue, American, Virgin America and Sun Country combined carried 175,400 more passengers in their domestic routes, and Delta and JetBlue together accounted for more than 85% of incremental passengers. The top five domestic destinations were LA, Fort Lauderdale, West Palm Beach, San Francisco and Boston. The top five international destinations with incremental seat capacity exceeding 10,000 were Dubai, London, Paris, Taipei and Zurich. Cargo sector returned to growth increasing 3% and pushing YTD up to 1.3%.
