

Regional passenger growth rose a healthy 4.8%, with domestic traffic up 4.0% and international up 6.7%. Mexican traffic increased 12% followed by Canada at 8%, Atlantic markets at 6.6% and the Caribbean, Central and South American markets at 5.7%. Regional freight declined (4.1%), for the third consecutive month.
