Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2007 TRAFFIC REPORT

Regional passenger traffic rose 8%, setting a new monthly record at 10.6 million passengers. American Transport Association member traffic rose 5.2%, giving the region a 2.8 percentage point advantage. JFK led with 12.1% passenger growth followed by Newark Liberty at 6.4% and LaGuardia at 2.7%. Freight declined (3.7%), with year-to-date freight down (1.8%). ATA member revenue freight ton miles rose 1.8% for the month.
