

## Aviation Department

Traffic at Kennedy International was off 1.8% in August, actually its best monthly performance since August of last year, as carriers reduced seat capacity by 4.4%. Domestic traffic was off 3.6% on a 5.2% decrease in capacity while international traffic was flat for its best monthly performance since October of last year.
