

Aviation Department

LaGuardia's monthly traffic fell by 1.2%, the least since August 2008, as carriers cut capacity 6.6%. The lone carrier to add capacity was new entrant to the market Southwest. Domestic traffic was down 0.7% on a 6.6% decrease in capacity.
