

Aviation Department

LaGuardia again led the region with 6.8 percent growth on a 4.7 percent increase in seat capacity. Domestic traffic gained 6.6 percent, while international traffic grew by 10.6 percent. Canadian traffic was buoyed by new service from Air Canada with passenger levels rising 7.6 percent over last August and up 2.3 percent from August 2008.
