

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2010 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Passenger traffic grew 1.8 percent on 2.3 percent fewer seats. The Board this month approved the terminal expansion plan, which will add 25,000 square feet of space, pushing airport capacity beyond the one million mark, while adding international FIS processing capacity. In addition, the Board approved a two-year incentive program to offset airline start-up costs for advertising, handling and flight fee charges for service to new markets. Stewart reported 977 freight tons in August for a 17.4 percent growth rate.
