Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily)" refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

Regional passenger traffic declined 3.6 percent on 3.9 percent more scheduled seats. Domestic passengers decreased 3.8 while international traffic fell 3.2 percent on scheduled seat gains of 4.7 percent and 2.6 percent respectively. By contrast, ATA U.S. flag carriers reported 0.2 percent growth. Hurricane Irene played havoc with airline schedules. Airport radar for Port Authority airports recorded 15,011 air carrier arrivals and departures for the week ending August 5 and only 10,305 for the week ending September 2, with zero flights for August 28, the day all regional airports closed. Regional freight decreased 7.2 percent.
