

Aviation Department

At JFK, passenger traffic grew 10.1% in August to reach 4.99 million, the highest monthly total ever. International passenger also experienced double-digit gains of 12.3% and set a new monthly record at 2.69 million, led by JetBlue, Delta and British Airways. Domestic traffic regained strength as it grew 7.7% despite 1.7% decline in seat capacity. The August gains pushed, YTD passenger growth to 4.6%. Growing at 2.9%, cargo experienced its first monthly positive gains in August led by a strong 10.4% gain in the domestic sector. However, YTD August cargo still remains weak, down 5.8%.
