

Aviation Department

With a 17% traffic growth in August, LGA remained the fastest growing among our airports. It also set a new monthly record as passenger levels exceeded the 2.5 million mark for the first time breaking the previous record of 2.4 million held since August 2001. Similarly, international traffic, which makes 5.3% of the airports passengers grew 69.5% on a 68% seat capacity gain and set a new monthly record at 173,232 passengers in August. The previous monthly record of 162,101 had been unbroken since August of 1989. Domestic traffic also grew 14.5% and set a new monthly record as it reached 2.36 million passengers, breaking the previous record established in 2001. The record passenger growth was attributable in part to the arrival of new Canadian carrier WestJet, expanded services by AA and Air Canada to Toronto and new services by Delta and Jetblue.
