

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

JFK's monthly passenger traffic exceeded 5 million for the first time following a 2% increase, and with international growing 5%, JFK also established a new monthly all-time high in the international sector by serving 2.8 million passengers, cementing the airport's status as the premier international gateway in the Northeast. Delta, JetBlue, Virgin Atlantic, Norwegian, ANA, Alitalia, Lot Polish and Emirates collectively carried 130,000 more passengers in August. Domestic passenger traffic contracted 1.5%. Dominant carriers on domestic destinations such as JetBlue, American and Virgin America collectively carried 67,000 fewer passengers this month compared to last year because of seat capacity reductions. Cargo tonnage was down 1.4% at JFK. International cargo contracted 0.8% and domestic tonnage was down 3.6%.
