

## Aviation Department

August 2014 was the airport's fifth consecutive record-setting month with 5.4 million passengers traveling through the airport. JFK handled 3.1 million international passengers, surpassing the 3 million mark for the first time ever. In addition, YTD August settled at an all-time high of 35.8 million, a 5.3% increase compared to the same period last year. Both domestic and international traffic increased, 6.3 and 8.7% respectively this month. YTD domestic traffic was up 3%. However, it is significantly behind the international traffic growth, which is up 7.4%. Cargo tonnage grew 1.3% at JFK. Even though domestic tonnage experienced a big attrition of 10.1%, a 4.1% growth in international cargo kept the levels positive at the airport with the YTD up 2.2%.
