

## Aviation Department

Passenger traffic grew 6.2%, led by a domestic sector that gained 5.2%. The international sector grew 7%. YTD growth continues to hover around 6.7 %, putting JFK on track for another record-breaking year in both the domestic and international markets. Airlines expanded domestic capacity by 5.5%, led by Delta's growth of 9.3%. JetBlue and AA were also net contributors. Carriers expanded international seat capacity 5%. Emirates, Delta, JetBlue, China Southern, Asiana, and LAN Airlines combined to carry 151,496 more passengers. JFK's cargo fell 3.2% in August.
