

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic fell (6.5%) on a (3.8%) seat drop. This was split between traffic losses of (6.7%) for domestic and (6.0%) for International markets. Continental traffic declined (4.6%) on a (2.5%) reduction in seats. American traffic declined (26.5%) on a (27.2%) reduction of seats from last December. Delta's (13.3%) traffic reduction came on a (2.5%) seat drop. Freight fell (13.7%) with international down (21.7%) to a domestic (10.8%) loss.
