

## Aviation Department

Traffic was down 1.6%, the third straight month of declines under two percent. JetBlue managed to grow its business for a second month in a row; it was up 5.3%. US Airways fell for the second month in a row; it was down a disappointing 17.1%. Delta grew for the first month in 2009; it was up 0.2% or 22 passengers. Cargo, down 2.7%, had its best month of 2009.
