Aviation Department

For the first time since 2006, passenger growth at LGA moved into positive territory. In the process the airport:

- handled 23.9 million passenger, leading to a growth of 8.3% in 2010;
- grew the fastest among our airports;
- was the only facility to maintain a balance growth in the form of positive growth for both domestic and international sectors;
- was the only airport in our system to experience a significant increase in flights; and,
- was the only facility to experience a reduction in the percentage of flights delayed even as the number of flights increased.
