

Aviation Department

For the first time since 2004-2005, passenger traffic at LGA grew two years in a row. Though 2011's passenger growth was only 0.6 percent, it pushed the passenger level slowly towards the all-time peak of 25.9 million achieved in 2005. The airport also welcomed back WestJet, a low-cost Canadian carrier, to the airport after a six-year absence and witnessed the conclusion of the Delta/USAirways swap, paving the way for Delta to transform LGA into a domestic hub.
