

LGA was the fastest-growing airport in our system as traffic increased 6.6 % to 25.7 million passengers, just 182,000 short of the all-time peak of 25.9 million achieved in 2005. Domestic grew 5.1% and international ended with a double digit record growth of 38.4%. Growth was attributed in large measure to Delta, whose commitment to LGA resulted in 23% increase in seat capacity, introduction of larger regional jets and addition of 26 new destinations.
