Though EWR did not set a record in 2013, it ended the year handling 35.1 million passengers, its highest level since 2008 and only 1.2 million shy of the 36.4 million peak it established in 2007. With 35.1 million passengers, EWR's traffic grew 3% the second highest rate among our facilities. In addition, domestic passenger traffic grew 3.9% and international traffic ended the year up 1.4% after being in negative territory for the first seven months of the year. EWR's cargo fell 10.8% in 2013. This represents the third year in a row that EWR experienced the sharpest cargo decline among our airport facilities. Freight volumes at the airport have been incrementally shrinking. They fell 8.7% in 2012 following a 5.6% drop in 2011. Domestic cargo was down 15.4% and international was down 1.8%.
