It was a remarkable year for LGA. Not only was it the fastest growing among our facilities with a 4 percent increase in passengers, the airport broke multiple records. It handled 26.7 million passengers, the highest ever, smashing the old record of 25.9 million passengers set in 2005 by 800,000 passengers. Among its other 2013 highlights, LaGuardia broke the previous domestic passenger record of 24.5 million set in 2006 by handling 25 million passengers, or 3 percent more than 2012. It also set a new international passenger record by handling 1.7 million passengers, about 300,000 higher than the previous record set in 2005 and 21 percent higher than 2012--the second consecutive year of 20-percent-plus international growth.
