

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ DECEMBER 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

For the second year in a row, SWF registered the only decline among our facilities in 2013. The airport served 320,682 passengers for a decline of 12.1% following a 11.8% drop in 2012. SWF's traffic levels always have had a tendency to swing wildly, primarily because of the limited number of carriers and flights. The decline was due in part to Delta's seat reduction to Detroit, and its elimination of service to Atlanta in September 2012, and JetBlue's switch from 158-seat A320s to smaller 100-seat regional jets for flights to Fort Lauderdale and Orlando in September 2012. Traffic improved in the tail end of the year due to US Airways' improved performance to Philadelphia and the re-entrance of a low-cost carrier, Allegiant with services to St. Petersburg, Florida. Stewart's cargo fell 8.4% due primarily to a reduction in FedEx activity.
