

Snow free December regional passenger traffic rose 5.9%, on a 10% spike in scheduled flights and 6.4% in scheduled seats, owing to a not so snow free December 2005. American Transport Association U.S. flag member airlines saw only a gain of 2.2% in passengers. Freight growth was near flat at a 0.3% gain.
