EWR reported the biggest gains in our airport system for the second year running, ending the year up 7 percent. The airport handled a record 43.4 million passengers, exceeding the previous year's record total by 2.8 million passengers. EWR also broke its domestic passenger record set in 2016, as it handled 30.5 million passengers - a net gain of 2.3 million and an 8.1 percent rise. EWR's international sector also set an all-time record as it handled 12.9 million passengers - up 4.3 percent. Similar to passenger traffic, EWR cargo's led the region in growth for the third consecutive year with a gain of 10.6 percent. Unlike last year, when the domestic sector set the pace, 2017's growth was led by the international sector, which entered double-digit territory with a 12.3 percent gain. The domestic sector, which constitutes nearly two-thirds of the airport's cargo, posted a 9.7 percent gain, led primarily by FedEx and United.
