For the third consecutive year, EWR reported the biggest gains among the major airports in our system as its passenger level grew 6.6 percent in 2018. Buoyed by a 6 percent increase in seat capacity, the airport handled a record 46.1 million passengers (+3 million passengers). EWR's international passenger traffic set an all-time record as it handled 14.1 million passengers (+9.7 percent/+1.2 million passengers). EWR broke its domestic passenger record set last year, as it handled 31.9 million passengers (+5.3 percent/+ 2 million travelers). Similar to passenger traffic, EWR's cargo led the region in growth for the fourth consecutive year with a gain of 3.1 percent. The international sector continued to set the pace with a gain of 5.6 percent. The domestic sector, which constitutes nearly two-thirds of the airport's total cargo traffic, posted a 1.8 percent gain.
