

# THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2006 TRAFFIC REPORT

## Aviation Department

The February 11 blizzard played havoc with traffic, causing a loss of about 3,500 flight movements or 4.7% of the regional total based on control tower records.

Nevertheless, passengers increased 1.8% -- just under 3 percentage points higher than the American Transport

Association average. Newark led with 8.9% growth, with

JFK and LGA in the negative one to two percent range.

Regional freight fell (2.9%).
