

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

SWF continues to experience passenger attrition, as February passenger traffic fell nearly 25%, pushing the YTD level down 20%. There were two additional contributing factors along with the tropical storm Nemo and a 2012 leap year February. The first, Delta reduced seat capacity to Detroit and completely eliminated service to its Atlanta hub. More importantly, JetBlue, the No. 1 carrier at the airport, switched from 158-seat A320 aircrafts to smaller 100-seat regional jets for its flights to Fort Lauderdale service.
