

**Aviation Department**

EWR benefitted from less severe weather as it posted strong 9.3% passenger traffic growth. Domestic and international travel jumped 10.3% and 7.3% respectively, following a 1.8% seat capacity increase. This suggests that compared to other facilities, where seat capacity expansions were much higher, the growth at EWR was solely attributable to less severe weather. United, JetBlue, Delta, American, and Alaska combined carried 161,000 incremental passengers in the domestic market, with United accounting for 76% of the gain. On their international destinations, United, Cathay, JetBlue, Austrian, and Scandinavian combined carried 51,300 more passengers. The cargo sector showed the strongest performance yet again at Newark with 11.4% increase.
