

## Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic declined 0.9% on 5.0% fewer seats. Domestic traffic fell 3.3% whereas international traffic rose by 1.7%. As for international markets, the Transpacific and Caribbean/Bermuda markets had the only substantial gains, 14.9% and 15.7% respectively. Atlantic markets were down 2.0%. Overall international traffic on foreign flag airlines was up 1.7% to the US flag average of 2.0%. Freight gained 16.2%.
