

Aviation Department

Newark traffic fell 7.3 percent on 0.3 percent fewer scheduled seats. Domestic passengers declined 10.9 percent on 3.2 percent fewer scheduled seats. International traffic declined as well, dropping 0.5 percent on 5.7 percent more seats. The Canadian market was the only one to show a gain, but it was a big one -traffic up 30.7% on an 11.8 percent seat gain.. Losses ranged from 0.9 percent for transpacific passengers to 15.2 percent for Mexican traffic. Freight increased 4.1 percent on a 2.9 percent increase in freighter flights. International freight grew 13.4 percent.
