

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2011 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

In spite of the record-breaking January snowfall, Kennedy traffic gained 1.5 percent. The gain reflected the resiliency, the important role and weight of international traffic at the airport. International traffic which makes up 50 percent of the airports traffic, experienced minimal cancellations and increased 4.3 percent, while domestic traffic fell 1.1 percent. Freight volume increased 9.2 percent, split between an 8.4 percent domestic and a 9.4 percent international gain. Freighter activity also increased 9.4 percent.
