

LaGuardia continues its reign as the regional traffic growth leader, now 19 months in a row, with a 2.4 percent gain on an 8.4 percent increase in scheduled seat capacity. Domestic traffic grew 2.1 percent, while the much smaller international segment accounted for 4 percent of LGA traffic, which rose 8.6 percent. The blizzard greatly distorts the January correlation between change in traffic to change in scheduled seats.
