

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic grew 3.7 percent on 4.7 domestic and 2.8 percent international gains. Scheduled seats fell by 2.6 percent, evenly split between domestic and international losses. By world grouping, the Pacific and Latin American markets showed gains of 10.1 percent and 15.6 percent. Transatlantic traffic declined 2.1 percent. Freight decreased 11.1 percent, split between a 1.9 percent domestic and a 13.1 percent international decline. Freighter operations fell 10.9 percent.
